Awards Competition Program

The purpose of the **Annual FPA Awards** competition is to recognize outstanding parking-related projects. It is hoped that the competition will continue to promote an appreciation of excellence in parking design, equipment, operation, and construction among the industry and the general public.

Eligibility

Projects submitted must have been completed between **June 1, of the previous year and June 30th of the current award year**. Only projects located in the State of Florida are eligible for the competition. You are invited to submit nominations in the following categories:

1. Parking Structure – New
2. Parking Structure- Renovated
3. Parking System – Most innovative and/or effective
4. Best Booth

Judging

Members of the FPA Board of Directors will serve as judges for categories 1, 2, 3 and 4. Projects will be judged based on outstanding conception, originality, and application in design, operation, management, and construction.

First round judging will take place in late fall. Finalists may be notified with requests for additional material to be judged during the final round.

Announcement of Awards

Grand Prize Winners and **Finalists** will be honored at the FPA Annual Conference.

Awards Ceremony

During the annual ceremony, each finalist will be recognized. The Awards Committee will create a presentation based on project photographs submitted. Owners and parking related designers, vendors, suppliers, and contractors will be recognized during the project narrative.

Form of Submission

Entries recommended for consideration should be submitted on the Awards Competition Prequalification Form located on the reverse of this sheet (or a duplicate thereof) with suitable photographs and descriptive data. Please note that photographs, details, or sketches demonstrating the unique use of parking innovations in design, operation, equipment, and construction will be taken into account by the judges. The submitted material must indicate the award category, as well as the outstanding features that merit judging.

All submissions must be received no later than October 31st of the award year. Incomplete submissions will be not be considered or returned.
